CRITERIA FOR THE M.O.R.E. PROJECT

Every Menard student is required to participate in the M.O.R.E. project.

The M.O.R.E. Project has the following criteria:

- The student must contact a person, group, or organization in need of service.
- The project is one with which Menard students do not normally come in contact.
- Please refrain from such projects that may be considered common chores such as: babysitting, raking leaves, mowing the lawn, etc.
- The project must be done in a manner to where the student receives no financial compensation for the task(s) performed.

SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING THE M.O.R.E. PROJECT (REVISED 2017)

I. Intent Form:

- A. Must be completed and turned in to religion teacher by due date. (50 points)
- B. Must be signed by student and parent.
- C. Must be approved by religion teacher before service hours can begin.

(If you have any questions, they may be addressed to the student's religion teacher.)

II. Documentation Form:

- A. Must contact agency where student will be volunteering to set dates and times.
- B. Hours required:
 1. Grades 7, 8, and 9—8 service hours
 2. Grades 10, 11, and 12—12 service hours
- C. Must document dates and times on Documentation Form. (50 points)
- D. Must have Documentation Form signed by supervisor at the site where service was performed.

III. Essay Form:

- A. Must be typed according to directions on Essay Form.
- B. Must be turned in to religion teacher by due date. (50 points)
- C. Must be 250-300 words, as outlined on Essay Form.

3. Find a scripture or a Saint quote to capture what you have learned from this experience and put it at the top of your essay or at the end.
4. Describe how you would convince someone to do the same volunteer work as you and what would be the benefit to them in doing this.

(1) Must present a 3-5 minute summary of experience. (50 points)

(2) Must answer the following questions:

(a) How has this affected my faith life?

(b) How can I convince others to serve in this way?
