Honors vs Non-Honors
Enrichment

- Where do my child's strengths and interests lie?
- What goals does my child have for him/herself? What goals do I have for my child? Do these goals complement or conflict with each other?
- Talk to your child's current teachers and ask about specific academic strengths and deficits. This information can be helpful in deciding a starting point in 7th grade!
- Standardized test scores and grades – what do they reflect?

7th Grade Course Offerings

- Honors courses in 7th grade lead to the possibility of High School Carnegie Unit courses in 8th grade – a head start on high school. Students MUST earn A/B in honors courses in 7th grade AND have the recommendation of the 7th grade teacher to be eligible for High School Carnegie Unit courses in 8th grade.
- Non-honors courses in 7th grade CAN lead to honors courses in later grades, with high grades, test scores, and teacher recommendations.


